

# ~ VINTAGE NOTES *1981* ~

## HARVEST 1981:

A vintage of low crop because of wet June during bloom. Very cool April, May and June with twice the normal precipitation. July began and remained warm and dry. August was hot. September was warm for three weeks then cool and damp. October was also cool and damp. Harvest in early October between the rains. A year in which many Oregon winemakers only produced White Pinot Noir.
