

# ~ VINTAGE NOTES *1987* ~

## HARVEST 1987:

Quantity and quality vintage generally very high. Moderate, relative dry April; warm and dry May and June. July cooler than normal, but satisfactory; August about the same until the end, when temperatures rose to the 90's. September offered perfect ripening temperatures and below average precipitation. Most Pinot Noir was picked by mid-September - one of the earliest harvests on record.
