

~ VINTAGE NOTES *1989* ~

HARVEST 1989:

In the late winter of 1989, Oregon suffered a severe freeze with temperatures at below -5 degrees. The consequence was moderate to serious vine damage and bud damage in the Spring of 1989. Crops were significantly reduced. The vintage was characterized by a late bud break, but a hot summer and fall harvest occurred in September. Quality was good to very good and the quantity was short.
